PUTNAM COUNTY, TN – **Putnam County Sheriff's Office Captures Robbery Subjects**

Sgt. Josh Reams and Putnam County Sheriff's Office deputies captured two alleged robbery subjects at Sharp Lodge located at 16139 Smithville Highway in Silver Point, Tennessee, at 5:30 p.m. yesterday. The subjects, Caleb Chase Reagan, 21, and Andrew Tyler Weatherby, 22, were wanted in connection with an aggravated robbery charge where they assaulted and injured a man in Overton County on Wednesday. After capture, the prisoners were transported to Overton County. A third subject, William Reagan, 22, was also taken into custody for a criminal court capias in Putnam County.

According to Major Terry Hembree, the Sheriff's Office received a Be On The Lookout (BOLO) from Overton County yesterday. After investigating several leads, Sergeant Reams and his deputies found the subjects' vehicle in the parking lot of the lodge. The manager identified the subjects and helped officers locate them within the lodge.

Sheriff Farris said, "I am very proud of how Sgt. Reams and our Warrants Division worked hand in hand with Overton and DeKalb Counties to relentlessly track these individuals who are wanted for criminal activity and take them into custody. All of the men and women of the Putnam County Sheriff's Office are committed to keeping our county safe from crime. We want criminals to know that if they enter Putnam County, we will use every tool at our disposal to track them down and capture them in order to keep our citizens safe."
